\*An evening session will be held beginning at 6:30 p.m., Monday, July 1, 1996. The purpose of the evening session will be to take customer testimony. In addition to the evening session, customers will be given the opportunity to present testimony at the beginning of the morning session on Monday, July 1, 1996.

All customers wishing to testify are urged to be present at the beginning of the sessions, since the sessions may be adjourned early if no customers are present.

PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE

The purpose of this hearing is to consider the application of Palm Coast Utility Corporation for increased water and wastewater rates and any motions or other matters that may be pending at the time of the hearing. The Commission may rule on any such motions from the bench or may take the matters under advisement.

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FPSC-RECORDS/REPORTING

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At the hearing, all parties shall be given the opportunity to present testimony and other evidence on the issues identified by the parties at the prehearing conference held on June 20, 1996. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony.


JURISDICTION
