

3. In this proceeding, the Commission will determine whether it will approve the subject co-carrier agreement pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 252(e)(1). Local exchange carriers are required under 47 U.S.C. § 252(i) to make available interconnection terms to any requesting carrier similar to those offered to any other carrier pursuant to an agreement approved under 47 U.S.C. § 252. MFS-FL, as a certificated Alternative Local Exchange Carrier, has substantial interests which will be directly affected by the Commission's consideration of the subject interconnection agreement.

**WHEREFORE**, Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. respectfully requests that it be allowed to intervene in this proceeding.
