RE: DOCKET NO. 960786-TL - CONSIDERATION OF BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S ENTRY INTO INTERLATA SERVICES PURSUANT TO SECTION 271 OF THE FEDERAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1996

Pursuant to section 271(d)(3) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996, the Federal Communication's Commission (FCC) has 90 days to issue a written determination approving or denying a Bell Operating Company's (BOC) application for interLATA authority. Further, the FCC is directed to consult with the applicable State Commission before making a determination regarding the BOC's entry into the interLATA market. See Section 271(d)(2)(b).

The Florida Public Service Commission has opened the above-captioned docket to begin to fulfill its consultative role. If you wish to actively participate in this docket, you should file a Petition for Leave to Intervene pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, with the Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, interested persons may intervene up until five (5) days prior to hearing. Although the hearing date has not been set, it is recommended that any potential intervenors file their petition as soon as possible. Parties take the case as they find it upon intervention.

Any person not desiring to intervene, but desiring to continue to receive notice of the activities in this proceeding, may request to be listed as an interested person for this docket. Such request must be made in writing to the Division of Records and Reporting pursuant to Rule 25-22.005, Florida Administrative Code.

If you do not file a Petition for Intervention or request to be an interested person by July 26, 1996, you will receive no further direct mailings regarding this docket.
