PURPOSE

The purposes of this workshop are as follows: 1) to discuss the conservation effect of an inverted rate; 2) to discuss the potential for a residential inverted rate to give residential customers market power that is currently enjoyed by large-use customers; 3) to evaluate the potential elimination of the customer charge and to evaluate hook-up charges for seasonal residents; 4) to determine whether there should be a phase-in period for a sharply inverted rate / customer charge reduction or elimination; and 5) to explore such other matters as may aid in the investigation of this matter.
