The application was filed pursuant to Rule 25-30.036(2), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) known as a Quick-Take Amendment. The type of amendment of certificate will be considered approved if no protest is timely filed to the notice of the Quick-Take Application and a completed follow-up application is filed in accordance with Rule 25-30.036(3), F.A.C., within 45 days after the utility completes the noticing requirements specified in Rule 25-30.030, F.A.C. The utility has submitted an application that we will consider the follow-up quick-take application. However, we are sending you a copy of the quick-take application on 3.5 inch diskette for your use in the future. After reviewing that application the staff has identified the following deficiencies as well as additional information that is needed to process the application.

1. As required by Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), the utility must provide notice of the application and provide evidence that the utility owns the land upon which the utility treatment facilities that will serve the proposed territory are located or a copy of an agreement, such as a 99-year lease, which provides for the continued use of the land. The utility provided a copy of a quit-claim deed, which is not sufficient. Staff needs a warranty deed, title insurance or an opinion of title from an attorney for the property.
