


Issue 1: Recommendation that the providers referenced in staff's September 26, 1996 memorandum should have their certificates cancelled if they fail to pay a \$250 fine and past due regulatory assessment fees within 30 days after the order becomes final. The fines are to be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to 364.285(1), F.S.

APPROVED

Issue 2: Recommendation that, if no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of the issuance date of the order, the provider will have 30 days from the date the order becomes final to pay a \$250 fine and all past due regulatory assessment fees or its certificate will be cancelled without further Commission action and the docket be closed. If any of these certificate numbers are cancelled--3848, 3869, 3952, 3731, and/or 3733--the serving local exchange company shall be directed to discontinue service to all pay telephones operated by that company. A protest of one docket should not prevent the action in a separate docket from becoming final.
