### QUALITY OF SERVICE

Issue: 1. Recommendation that the quality of service is unsatisfactory.

- Issue: 2. Recommendation that to follow up on the consent order, and the quality of service, the following actions be ordered:
  - By August 1, 1987, the Utility will send a letter to the Commission explaining what their plans are to come into compliance with the DER consent order. This letter will also be enclosed in the August, 1987 billing to each customer.
  - 2. By August 1, 1988, the Utility will send a letter to the Commission explaining what is being designed, under construction or has been built to come into compliance with the DER consent order. This letter will also be enclosed in the August, 1988 bill to each customer.
- Recommendation that the Utility install a valve or other apparatus as soon as possible to stop water from flowing over the storage tank, when the storage tank is full.
