BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company") hereby files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Request For Specified Confidential Classification for the PATS Access Lines Quarterly Report.

1. In a Memorandum dated September 23, 1991, the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission"), requested that all local exchange companies submit pay telephone data on a quarterly basis for both LEC and NON-LEC pay stations.

2. BellSouth filed its response to this request on October 16, 1996. At that time, BellSouth also filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

3. BellSouth is filing its Request for Confidential Classification because the information contained in this quarterly report is clearly confidential and proprietary, and therefore, entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Sections 119.07(3)(w) and 364.183, Florida Statutes.

4. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as "Attachment A" a list of the location in the response of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential. Appended hereto labeled

"Attachment B" is one copy of the response with the confidential information deleted.

5. "Attachment C" contains a sealed envelope containing one copy of the response (on diskette), including the material that is confidential and proprietary (and which was filed on October 16, 1996 with BellSouth's Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

6. The information provided is customer-specific information. The customer-specific information includes telephone numbers, names and addresses, and billing names and addresses. This information is confidential pursuant to Section 119.07(3)(w), Florida Statutes.

7. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the material for which confidential classification is sought as private. This information has not been generally disclosed.

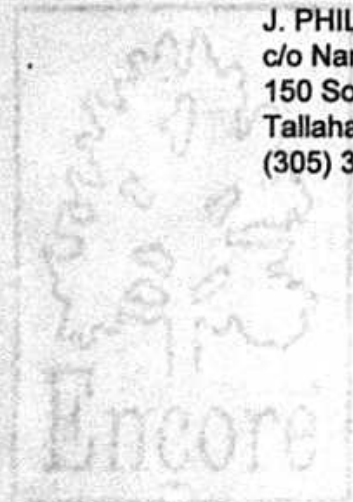

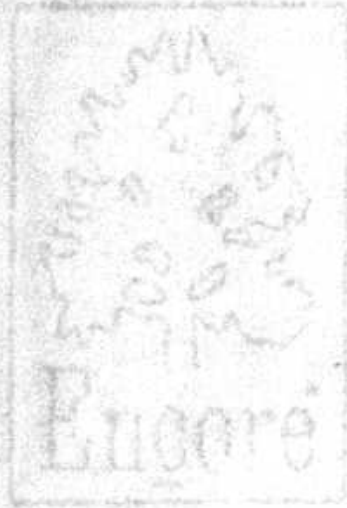

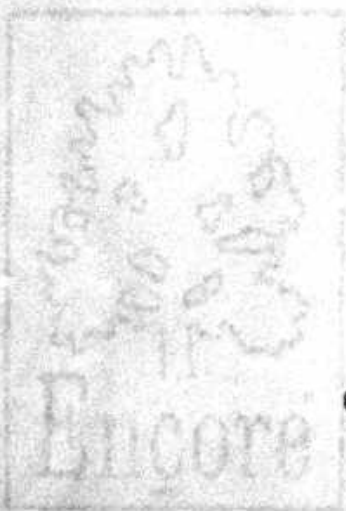
