RE: DOCKET NO. 961196-WS - Request for variance from Order No. PSC-1180-FOF-WS by Rolling Oaks Utilities, Inc. in Citrus County.

Issue 1: Recommendation that Rolling Oaks' request for a variance from Order No. PSC-96-1180-FOF-WS should be granted. If, the Commission approves the recommendation, Rolling Oaks' tariffs for gross-up authority will not be cancelled. However, the utility should be required to notify the Commission when the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) rules on its private letter ruling so that the tariffs can be cancelled.

Issue 2: Recommendation that Rolling Oaks' request to refund the post June 12, 1996, CIAC gross-up collections should not be implemented along with the annual filing of its 1996 CIAC report to the Commission regarding its collection of gross-up. The utility should be ordered to comply with the refunding requirements of Order No. PSC-96-1180-FOF-WS. If the Commission approves the recommendation, the utility should be required to provide copies of cancelled checks, or other evidence, verifying that the refunds have been made, within 30 days from the date of the refund.
