Dear Mr. LaFond:

This letter is in response to your question regarding the appropriate method for delivery of customer billing.

Rule 25-30.335(4), Florida Administrative Code, provides that a utility may not consider a customer delinquent in paying his or her bill until the 21st day after the utility has mailed or presented the bill for payment. Therefore, it appears that under the rule the utility may either mail or present bills to the customers. However, the rule does not specifically address what it means to "present" a bill.
