Dear Mr. Williams:

This law firm represents TresCom. Further to our telephone conversation on January 6, 1997, please accept this letter as a formal request for approval of a transfer of control to TresCom of the customer base of United States Digital Network, L.P. ("USDN"), and the assignment by USDN to TresCom of the certificate and tariff (the "USDN Certificate") issued to USDN by the Florida Public Service Commission. TresCom is currently authorized to resell interexchange services in the State of Florida pursuant to the certificate of the Florida Public Service Commission, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof. Pursuant to a certain Purchase and Sale Agreement, dated as of November 1, 1996, USDN sold to TresCom, and TresCom purchased from USDN, USDN's entire customer base and certain other assets of USDN, including the USDN Certificate. TresCom does not plan to cancel the USDN Certificate, and will continue to bill the existing Florida customers of USDN under the name of USDN.

The undersigned hereby requests that the Florida Public Service Commission approve said transfer of control of the USDN customer base.
