Dear Commissioner Johnson:

I have been notified of the Public Service Commission's decision to reject your staff's recommendation regarding the 904 area code change. I respectfully ask that the PSC reconsider its decision and allow us to speak again before the Commission.

Jacksonville has just completed a long-range strategy to expand our economic development international businesses. A change in our area code would badly hamper our efforts. Hundreds of businesses are dependent upon directory listings in Latin America, the Orient and Europe. The majority of these orders come via fax because it reduces the language barrier. A change would essentially have them misfiled for 12-24 months as this is the usual life span of their directories.


