I was the witness for Sprint-United and Sprint-Centel in Docket No. 941281-TL, which dealt with 11 the proper tariffing of telephone service for elevators 12 and common areas within residential facilities. I also 13 testified in Docket No. 930173-TL, Polo Park EAS, and 14 Docket No. 941281-TL, Groveland EAS involving United 15 16 exchanges.

- A. Yes. Exhibit One to this testimony is a traffic study 3 for the Sprint routes involved in this proceeding. It 4 was prepared under my direction and supervision and is 5 true and correct to the best of my knowledge. 6 contains information Sprint believes to be proprietary 7 8 confidential business information, so a redacted version has been included with this testimony. The confidential 9 10 version, with the confidential information highlighted. was submitted to the Division of Records and Reporting 11 under a confidential cover with a Request for 12
- 15 Q. Which routes in this Docket involve Sprint exchanges?

Confidential Classification.

- 17 A. Haines City to Fort Meade is the only route involving a

 18 Sprint exchange. Fort Meade is a Sprint exchange.
- 20 Q. Did Sprint conduct traffic studies on this route?
- 22 A. Yes. Sprint recently conducted a traffic study on this
 23 route, and it is attached as Exhibit One. In Order No.
 24 PSC-95-1429-PCO-TL, issued November 27, 1995, the
 25 Commission recognized the Fort Meade, Avon Park (pocket)

1 and Bowling Green exchanges as being interLATA. Order stated that the routes would not be studied since 2 GTEFL could not provide traffic studies on interLATA 3 routes. Based on that Order, no traffic studies were 4 prepared at that time. 5 6 7 Q. What is Sprint's position in this Docket? 8 Traffic study results on the Ft. Meade to Haines City 9 route reflect calling rates that are not sufficient to 10 meet the requirements for messages per access line per 11 month (M/A/Ms), or frequency distribution to qualify for 12 balloting for flat rate, non-optional Extended Area 13 Service (EAS) or the implementation of any form of toll 14 relief. 15 16 What other community of interest factors should be 17 Q. considered in determining if either an optional or 18 non-optional interLATA toll alternative should be 19 implemented? 20 21 In addition to traffic studies, there are some factors 22 A. often mentioned by subscribers desiring EAS. 23 factors may include the location of schools, fire/police 24

departments, medical emergency facilities, and county

government.

The Fort Meade Exchange currently has EAS to Lakeland, which is the County Seat, and Bartow, where the State and Federal Offices serving this area are located.

Schools are located within the Fort Meade Exchange, and medical requirements that can not be handled by the Fort Meade Medical Center are most often handled via medical facilities in Lakeland, which as mentioned above is EAS.

Q. Should the Commission determine that an alternative toll plan such as ECS should be implemented, what is the economic impact on the Company?

A. Based on the monthly calling volume reflected in the traffic study, the estimated annual revenue impact to the Company would be a loss of approximately \$5,460 if there is no stimulation on the route. A 50% stimulation, which is consistent with the factor used by Southern Bell in Docket No. 920260-TL, would result in a revenue loss of approximately \$3,855. These dollars do not reflect the additional costs for facilities that would be required to carry the traffic, or other administrative costs associated with the implementation of the toll

1 alternative. 2 Commission should determine Q. If the that EAS íø. 3 a propriate, should subscribers be required to pay an 4 additive as a prerequisite to implementation?
