All traffic data collected for the calling rate computation for this study is based on the January 31, 1997 billing period. This study included Business, Public Paystations, Customer-Owned Paystations and Residence. The study excludes test lines and official company lines.

All data reported in this study is based only on the usage which Frontier Communications of the South, Inc. bills on behalf of specific interexchange carriers (IXCs). To the extent other IXCs may be carrying traffic of which we are unaware, the data may be affected. Usage of this type is not available for study by Frontier Communications of the South, Inc. since we do not perform the recording and billing function for all other carriers.

The Molino exchange of Frontier Communications of the South, Inc. has no FX lines.

The community of interest for the citizens residing in the Molino area is Pensacola. This is where they would go for medical facilities, business information, employment, shopping and entertainment.

On the enclosed map the existing EAS routes are shown with solid arrows and the proposed routes are shown with broken arrows.

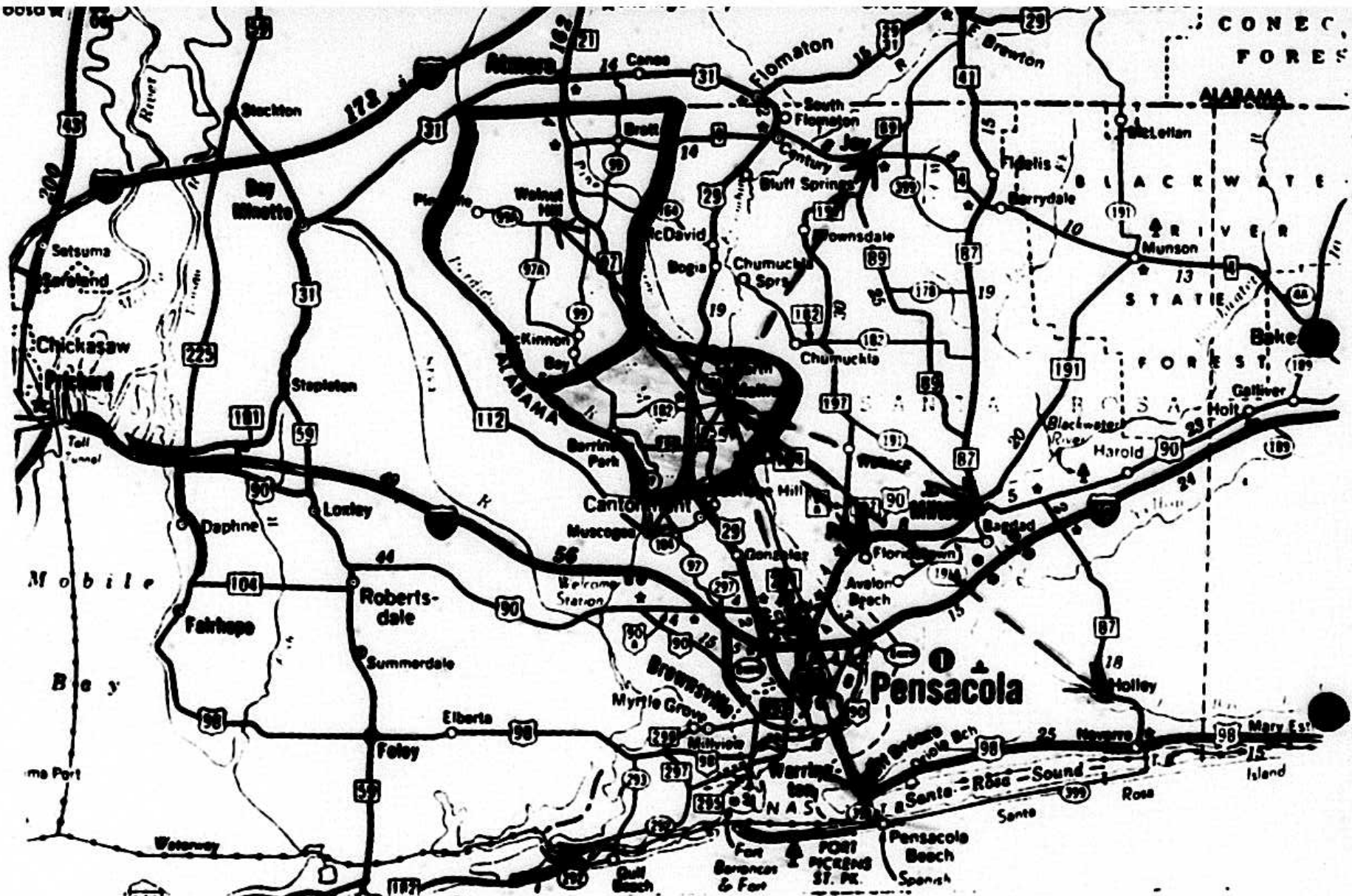




