NOTICE OF APPLICATION

W.B.B. UTILITIES, INC. will apply to the Florida Public Service Commission for an Allowance for Funds Prudently Invested (AFPI) Charge along with increase in Plant Capacity Charges and System Capacity Charges. These charges are to pay for growth in the utility system. The charges are to be paid by new connections and not existing customers. A copy of the Application may be inspected at W.B.P. Utilities, Inc., 4116 Bair Avenue, Fruitland Park, Florida 34731

\$220 It is proposed that the Plant Capacity Charge for water be increased from \$220 to \$828 and the system sepecity charge be increased from \$200 to \$925 per Equivalent Residential Connection (ERC). It is also proposed that an AFPI charge be initiated which will be capped over a five year period.

An Equivalent Residential Connection means (a) 350 gallons per day for water; (b) the number of gallons a utility demonstrates is the average daily flow for a single residential unit; or (c) the number of gallons which have been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection for a single residential unit.

An Allowance for Funds Prudently Invested (AFPI) Charge is a mechanism which allows a utility an opportunity to earn a fair rate of return on prudently constructed plant held for future use from the future customers to be served by that plant in the form of a charge paid by those customers.
