MOTION OF FLORIDA POWER CORPORATION FOR LEAVE TO FILE AMENDED PETITION

Florida Power Corporation ("Florida Power") hereby move the Prehearing

Officer for leave to amend its petition initiating this docket, and states as follows:

Florida Power's original petition requested approval of certain enumerated revisions to the program participation standards of Florida Power's Residential Home Energy Improvement and Residential New Construction Programs. Subsequently, Florida Power became aware of certain information which suggested the desirability of expanding the Residential Home Energy Improvement Program's duct leakage repair component to include multi-family rental units. Florida Power also desires to include several "housekeeping" revisions suggested by Staff to clarify two provisions each in the program participation standards for the Residential Home Energy Improvement Program and the Residential New Construction Program. In all other respects the revisions in Florida Power's original petition will remain unchanged.

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WHEREFORE, Florida Power Corporation respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer grant Florida Power leave to file its Amended Petition, copies of which have been submitted herewith.
