Dear Mr. Martin:

Mountain Lake Corporation's (Mountain Lake) application for a water certificate requires additional information to fulfill requirements of Rule 25-30.035, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

1) The utility shall provide evidence that the utility owns the land upon which the utility treatment facilities are located, or a copy of an agreement which provides for the continued use of the land, such as a 99-year lease. The Commission may consider a written easement or other cost effective alternative, per Rule 25-30.035(6), F.A.C. The deed submitted with your application does not appear to have been recorded. Staff requests that the utility submit a copy of a recorded deed or other documentation which comports with the Rule.


2) The utility shall provide one copy of a detailed system map showing the lines, treatment facilities and the territory to be served, per Rule 25-30.035(10), F.A.C. Staff requests that the utility provide clear detailed information demonstrating the service lines of the utility.

3) The utility shall provide a schedule showing the number of customers currently served by class and meter size, as well as the number of customers projected to be served when the service territory is fully occupied per, Rule 25-30.035(13), F.A.C.

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
