<u>Issue 2:</u> Recommendation that the Commission require all telecommunications carriers to bear their own cost of providing the interim number portability solutions identified in Table A of staff's March 20, 1997 memorandum. No matter which cost recovery mechanism is adopted, all local exchange companies should be required to modify/file their tariffs to recognize the ILNP solutions identified in Table A and the rates charged, if any.

Approved with modification that LECO MODIFIED will be required to hack casts of providing interior runken portability Salutions until FCC issues its permanent number portability order, with the understanding that these costs are potentially recoverable.

<u>Issue 3:</u> Recommendation that the Commission's decision in this proceeding should not be applied retroactively to the effective date of the FCC's order on interim number portability or any other such past date. The Commission should apply its decision prospectively from the effective date of the order issued in this proceeding.
