

The Florida Public Service Commission announces a Staff Workshop to be held in the following matter, to which all interested persons and parties are invited to attend.

DOCKET NO. 970001-EI - Fuel and purchased power cost recovery clause and generating performance incentive factor.

DATE AND TIME: Friday, May 30, 1997, 9:30 a.m.

PLACE: Commission Training Room 171, Betty Easley Conference Center, 4075 Esplanade Way, Tallahassee, Florida

PURPOSE: This workshop will address the effect of FERC Order 888 on the establishment of prices for economy, Schedule C, broker transactions and the recovery of the costs associated with these transactions from retail ratepayers. FERC Order 888 requires jurisdictional utilities to file unbundled wholesale power tariffs and take transmission service for their own wholesale transactions under the terms and conditions of the tariff. Each utility will be asked to discuss the methodology used by the utility prior to FERC Order 888 to determine energy broker transaction prices and the associated costs to be recovered, and any changes made in the methodology in response to the FERC order. In addition, proposals

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for the appropriate methodology for accounting for transmission costs in broker transaction prices and for recovering (crediting) the costs (revenues) will be discussed.
