# RESPONSE TO A LETTER DATED MAY 6, 1997 FROM SENATOR ANNA P. COWIN TO CHAIRMAN JOHNSON

The Florida Waterworks Association ("FWA") hereby files this its response to a letter dated May 6, 1997, from Senator Anna P. Cowin to Chairman Johnson, and states:

1. The Office of Public Counsel (OPC) was created by the Legislature. The Public Counsel is appointed by the Legislative Auditing Committee. The Legislature has delegated to OPC the responsibility of representing the citizens of Florida before the Florida Public Service Commission (Section 350.0611, F.S.). Pursuant to Section 350.0613, Florida Statutes, OPC is furnished with copies of initial pleadings filed with the Commission and granted authority to intervene in any proceeding before the Commission. The Legislature has provided OPC with sufficient funds to maintain a highly trained and experienced professional staff.

2. The Commission has been formally considering used and useful, including margin reserve, in rule making, since 1991. This most recent rule making proceeding was noticed as required by Florida Statute. Notice of rulemaking was served on July 26, 1996. The notice was published in FAW on August 2, 1996.

3. OPC has participated fully in this docket. OPC filed written comments prior to the hearing, attended and participated in the December 1996 hearing, cross-examined witnesses, and filed post-hearing comments stating its position on the proposed rule. Additionally, Mr. Twomey, an attorney, who is one of the Senator's advisors attended the December hearing but did not participate.

4. The Commission scheduled this docket for consideration at its April 24, 1997 agenda. This docket was taken off that agenda, not considered, and as of this date not scheduled for another agenda.

5. It is not appropriate to further delay this proceeding. The citizens of Florida through OPC have been vigorously represented. There has been no allegation that any new relevant evidence or testimony could be produced for the Commission's consideration.
