RE: DOCKET NO. 960216-TI - Initiation of show cause proceedings against World Access Communications Corp. for violation of Rule 25-24.4701, F.A.C., Provision of Regulated Communications Service to Uncertificated Resellers Prohibited.

Issue 1: Should the Commission accept World Access Communications Corporation's proposed settlement offer in lieu of continuing the show cause proceeding against the company for violation of Rule 25-24.4701, Florida Administrative Code, Provision of Regulated Communications Service to Uncertificated Reseller Prohibited?

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept World Access Communications Corporation's proposed settlement to pay a \$3,500 contribution to the Commission to be deposited in the Florida General Revenue Fund, to comply with all aspects of Rule 25-24.4701, Florida Administrative Code, and to provide the Commission and Telecuba within 30 days from the date the Order becomes final all necessary information so that Telecuba can accomplish a refund to affected customers.
