I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

AUDIT PURPOSE:

We have applied the procedures described in Section II of this report in order to audit the Rate Base of Sunray Utilities (St.Johns and Nassau) for the period ending December 31, 1996.

DISCLAIM PUBLIC USE:

This is an internal accounting report prepared after performing a limited scope audit. Accordingly, this document must not be relied upon for any purpose except to assist the Commission Staff in the performance of their duties. Substantial additional work would have to be performed to satisfy generally accepted auditing standards and produce audited financial statements for public use.

OPINION:

Subject to the Audit Exceptions and Disclosures contained in this report, the schedules of Rate Base as of December 31, 1996 represent company books and records maintained in substantial compliance with Commission directives. The expressed opinions extend only to the scope of the work described in Section II of this report.

SUMMARY DISCLOSURES:

For Sunray-Nassau, the utility was unable to provide documentation to support \$26,860 of Water Plant and \$14,500 of Sewer Plant.

For Sunray-Nassau (Water), the utility has \$36,000 of Land purchased in anticipation of an expansion in Water Plant operations; however, this construction of additional Water Plant has not occurred.

For Sunray-St.Johns, the Water Plant is overstated by \$7,500 and the Sewer Plant is understated by \$7,500.

For Sunray-St.Johns, the utility filed a 1995 Annual Report with the St. Johns Water and Sewer Authority and listed the existence of Nonused and Useful Plant; however, the utility desires that those amounts listed as Nonused and Useful be declared void for the purpose of establishing the Sunray-St.Johns Rate Base for the acquisition by United Water.

II. AUDIT SCOPE:

The opinions contained in this report are based on the audit work which is described below. When used in this report Compiled means that audit work includes:

Compiled: Means that the audit staff reconciled exhibit amounts with the General Ledger; visually scanned accounts for error or inconsistency; disclosed any unresolved error, irregularity, or inconsistency; and, except as otherwise noted, performed no other audit work.

RATE BASE:

Compiled Rate Base for the period ending December 31, 1996; established schedules of Plant accounts from January 1, 1988 to December 31, 1996; traced Plant account balances to the General Ledgers and/or the Audit Trail Reports (the Audit Trail Report is a company specific document providing greater details per transaction than that contained in the utility's General Ledger) from January 1, 1988 to December 31, 1996; traced Plant Account Summary Ledger to the General Ledger as of December 31, 1995; utilized auditor judgement to select transactions within the Plant accounts for verification of transactions from ledger to invoice to check and/or to other documentation; identified Plant items not to be sold by the utility [Sunray-Nassau Water] as exclusions from the rate base per United Water acquisition; identified Sunray general Plant items to be sold by the utility as inclusions into the rate base per United Water acquisition; compared (for each category of Plant) the asset life used for depreciation purposes by the utility to the F.P.S.C. asset life guidelines within the Commission rule: traced Contributions in Aid of Construction (C.I.A.C.) balances to the General Ledger and/or Audit Trail Report from January 1, 1988 to December 31, 1996; traced Accumulated Amortization of C.I.A.C. balances to the General Ledger and/or the Audit Trail Report from January 1, 1988 to December 31, 1996.

III. AUDIT DISCLOSURES:

AUDIT DISCLOSURE No. 1

SUBJECT: MISSING DOCUMENTATION TO SUPPORT PLANT.

STATEMENT OF FACT: The utility was unable to provide documentation to support \$26,860 of Water Plant at Sunray Nassau and \$14,960 of Sewer Plant at Sunray Nassau.

AUDIT DISCLOSURE No. 2

SUBJECT: LAND PURCHASED FOR FUTURE EXPANSION OF WATER PLANT.

STATEMENT OF FACT: The utility has Land Held for Future Use of \$36,000 at Sunray Nassau (Water). In August 1988, the utility purchased \$36,000 of Land (per JV08-07 for Rayland parcel 85-1-2). The utility states that it had purchased the land in anticipation of an expansion/construction of additional Water Plant. However, the expansion of the additional Water Plant has not yet occurred. The utility considers that Land as being a site for the future expansion of Water operations.

AUDIT DISCLOSURE No. 3

SUBJECT: WATER PLANT OVERSTATED AND SEVER PLANT UNDERSTATED.

STATEMENT OF FACT: The utility at Sunray St. Johns has overstated Water plant and understated Sewer Plant. The amount is \$7,500. In April 1992. a check (Number 020844) was paid to JAX Utilities Management Inc. in the amount of \$9,236 for three invoices: Invoice# 000274 (\$440), Invoice# 001826 (\$1,296), and Invoice# 001827 (\$7,500). A review of Invoice# 001827 (\$7,500) shows that it was for the Sewer Treatment plant; however the \$7,500 cost was allocated into the Water Treatment plant account. Therefore, Water plant is currently overstated by \$7,500 and Sewer plant is currently understated by \$7,500.

AUDIT DISCLOSURE No. 4

SUBJECT: PLANT NONUSED AND USEFUL.

STATEMENT OF FACT: The auditor reviewed the utility's Annual Report for Sunray Utilities --- St. Johns, Inc. for the Calendar Year Ending 1995 (filing date July 1, 1996) as filed before the St. John's County Water and Sewer Authority. On page F-4 of their report, the St. John's County Water and Sewer Authority requests identification of Nonused and Useful Plant (with a footnote that states "Estimated if not known"). The auditor observed that the utility had entered the following information on that line of page F-4:

Water Sewer Utility Utility

Nonused and Useful Plant

\$390,873.24

\$625,804.50

The auditor made an inquiry (via Document Request) to the Accounting Manager of Sunray Utilities requesting a detailed explanation of these amounts, the estimation methodology utilized, and an indication as to whether United Water (the acquiring entity) had knowledge of the situation. The Accounting Manager of Sunray Utilities responded and indicated (1) that when she had entered the amounts onto the Annual Report, she did not have the engineering data to accurately determine any amount of Nonused and Useful Plant and (2) that she had utilized an estimation procedure which appears to have led to an overstatement of Nonused and Useful Plant.

The Accounting Manager of Sunray Utilities desires that her numbers entered for Nonused and Useful Plant be declared void for the purpose of establishing the Sunray-St.Johns Rate Base for the acquisition by United Water. A detailed letter from her regarding this matter (the circumstances of the St. Johns Authority filing, the estimation procedure that she utilized, etc.) is included within the Work Papers of the auditor. According to the Accounting Manager of Sunray Utilities verbal statements: "To the best of my knowledge, all plant/land (other than the \$36,000 Sunray Nassau Land held for future Water use), is currently completely useful, is being used, and is fully operational at the St. Johns Utility for Water & for Sewer and at the Nassau Utility for Water & for Sewer."
