TECO is requesting confidential treatment of certain portions of Mr. Charles R. Black's direct testimony in Docket No. 970001-EL Document Nos. 06385-97 and 06785-97. Document No. 06785-97 supersedes Document No. 06385-97; thus, Document No. 06385-97 may be returned to TECO. The information relates to TECO's 1996 Waterborne Transportation Benchmark and the Gatliff Coal Price Benchmark. This information is considered proprietary by TECO since knowledge of prices paid for coal and transportation services puts TECO at a disadvantage during negotiations. TECO further requests that the information remain confidential for a period of two years when at such time conditions will have changed such that the information will no longer be useful.
