RE: DOCKET NO. 970646-TP - Petition for partial waiver of Rule 25-4.113(4), F.A.C., by Time Warner Connect.

Issue 1: Should the Commission grant Time Warner's petition for a waiver from the provisions of Rule 25-4.113(4)(e), Florida Administrative Code, which prohibits telephone companies from discontinuing service to a customer failing to pay for a company service which is not regulated by the Commission?

Recommendation: Yes. Time Warner's request for a waiver of Rule 25-4.113(4)(e) should be granted, thus allowing Time Warner to disconnect long distance services to customers who fail to pay the combined balance on a bill containing charges for both regulated and non-regulated services. Further, Time Warner should be ordered to notify customers prior to their election of combined billing that it is purely an option to separate billing. Time Warner should be required to state that a customer may return to separate billing at no additional charge.
