

**WORLDCOM, INC.'S REQUEST FOR
CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

Now comes WorldCom, Inc. d/b/a LDDS WorldCom, for itself and its affiliates/subsidiaries WorldCom Network Services, Inc. d/b/a Wiltel Network Services and Biztel Corporation (hereinafter, collectively "WorldCom"), and files this Request for Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

1. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-97-0604-FOF-TP, issued May 27, 1997, all facilities-based interexchange carriers, including WorldCom, were required to file tariff reductions to flow-through access charge reductions ordered by the PSC. In compliance with that order, WorldCom submitted supporting documentation for the tariff reductions on September 2, 1997.

2. Accompanying the filing was a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification of certain information within the document. The information which WorldCom asserts is confidential in is found on page 1 of Attachment A and in Attachment B.

3. WorldCom requests confidential treatment of that data for the following reasons:
a. Attachment A, page 1. Columns "% Reduction" "SW Access Charges" and "SW Acc. Savings" contain proprietary revenue data which, if revealed, would disclose information from which market activity could be derived. Information on activity is of value to competitors and public disclosure would adversely affect WorldCom.


