Provide revised schedules for the above referenced schedules which contain legible numbers.

- 2. The St. John's Water Management District Consumptive Use Permit (Issued 2/13/90) is illegible. Provide a legible copy of this WMD consumptive use permit.
- 3. Although Schedules 4 and 5 were provided which propose rates for recovering rates, these schedules do not contain the necessary data used by the utility to calculate its proposed rates. The following information should be provided:

For Schedule No. 4:

- a. Provide the source for the 1,039,367 gallons. This should include a billing analysis for the wastewater customers broken down by customer class and meter size.
- b. Provide the ERCs and gallons used to calculate the base facility and usage charges.
- c. Provide the percentages used to allocate the reuse revenue requirement to the base facility and gallonage charges for the effluent disposal customers.

For Schedule No. 5:

- a. Provide documentation supporting the 401,865 gallons projected to be used by the irrigation customers.
- b. Provide the ERCs and gallons used to calculate the base facility and usage charges.
- c. Provide the percentages used to allocate the reuse revenue requirement to the base facility and gallonage charges for the irrigation customers and the effluent disposal customers.

In order to comply with the requirements of Section 367.0817, Florida Statutes, the applicant must provide the above requested information. Your application will not be deemed filed and an official filing date will not be established until we have received the above requested information required by statute.

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In addition, Section 367.0817(3), Florida Statute, provides that the utility can recover the costs of a reuse project from the utility's water, wastewater, or reuse customers, or any combination thereof as deemed appropriate by the Commission. In order for staff to explore the sharing of the reuse costs with the utility's water customers, we will need a complete billing analysis for a twelve month period. We request that you provide a billing analysis broken down by customer class and meter size for the twelve month period ending December 31, 1996, for this purpose.

The requested information should be submitted no later than October 20, 1997.
