9	MR. LOGAN: She won't be here today, but
10	she'll be at the hearing.
11	MS. BROWN: Martha Carter Brown and John
12	Bowman on behalf of the Florida Public Service
13	Commission Staff.
14	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Counsel, are there any
15	preliminary matters?
16	MS. BROWN: Well, Commissioner, there aren't
17	really any preliminary matters that we have to decide
18	here, but I did want to bring you up to date on a few
19	things.
20	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Okay.
21	MS. BROWN: Initially, Teleport filed
22	testimony and proposed several issues in this case.
23	They have since withdrawn that testimony and withdrawn
24	their proposed issues. We do have two issues in the

25 case. In the order establishing procedure there was

one, we have added one that is reflected in the Prehearing Order and we can get to that. 2 I think that's all I really wanted to bring 3 you up to date on. I have no other preliminary 5 matters. MR. WILLINGHAM: I do have two that I would 6 like to bring up. There's two orders that we would 7 like to have the Commission take official recognition 9 of. COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Okay. 10 The first one is its own 11 MR. WILLINGHAM: previous order, PSC-95-1048-FOF-TL. That was the 12 13 previous 305 --COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Run that by me again. 14 It's PSC-95-1048-FOF-TL. MR. WILLINGHAM: 15 It's an August 23, 1995 Order for the previous 305 17 split. COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Okay. 18 MR. WILLINGHAM: And the second is an order 19 from the Public Utilities Commission for the state of Colorado. It's decision No. C97-761 and I've provided 21 a copy of that order to all the parties. 22 COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Okay. 23 MS. BROWN: Commissioner, you could rule on 24 that if you want, or we can wait until the beginning

of the hearing. Staff has no objections. They've had a chance to review the --2 COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Then we'll take 3 official recognition of those two orders. 4 MS. BROWN: Commissioner, you might want to 5 ask the parties if any of the parties object. 6 MR. EARLY: No objection. 7 MS. WHITE: No objection. 8 MR. BOND: No objection. 9 COMMISSIONER GARCIA: All right. That being 10 done, we'll go through the Prehearing Order, and we'll 11 go section by section. If anybody has any problems 12 | we'll go through it. 13 | All right. Corrections or changes to the 14 15 | case background? MR. WILLINGHAM: If we could back up just a 16 second. 17 COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Sure. 18 MR. WILLINGHAM: I would ask that we add 19 Michael Mcrae's name, the representation for Teleport. He's in-house counsel for Teleport, and his name has 21 been on everything that's been filed so far. 22 MS. BROWN: We will do that. We were 23 looking for his name and address on the petition to intervene and whether he was -- where we could find

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1	it. We'll look on other filings for his address.
2	MR. WILLINGHAM: It's definitely on the
3	amended prehearing statement we just filed.
4	MS. BROWN: Or you can give it to me.
5	MR. BOND: Okay, thanks.
6	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Great. Very good.
7	Nothing on the case background? Go through order of
8	witnesses. Basic positions, do we need to go one by
9	one or is everyone pretty much satisfied with what we
10	have.
11	MR. WILLINGHAM: TCG's will change in
12	accordance with the amended prehearing statement that
13	hopefully has been filed by now, but a copy has been
14	provided to all the parties.
15	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Okay.
16	MS. WHITE: Issue No. 2 was new to
17	BellSouth. BellSouth will formulate a response and
18	give it to the Staff tomorrow.
19	COMMISSIONER GARCIA: Okay.
20	MR. WILLINGHAM: And also on Issue No. 2,
21	TCG had withdrawn that issue and this is not our
22	response at this time. But I'm not sure if we're I
23	guess we can provide one tomorrow.
