**AT&T's NOTICE OF INTENT
TO REQUEST SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION
AND REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Comes now AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc., (AT&T) and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code and Section 364.183, Florida Statutes, files this Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification and Request for Temporary Protective Order.

1. On September 10, 1997, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a Request for Production of Documents upon AT&T. AT&T filed its initial objections to certain portions of such request on September 22, 1997.

2. Certain documents and information requested by OPC are confidential and proprietary under Florida Statutes, Section 364.183 and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Statutes. Because this information is proprietary, AT&T is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification in order to allow OPC to review and take possession of such documents and information without delay. AT&T also moves for a Temporary Protective Order exempting these documents from Section 119.07, Florida Statutes. The

Once Public Counsel notifies AT&T that any of the proprietary documents are to be used in a proceeding before the Commission, AT&T will file a detailed Motion for Protective Order specifically addressing each of the documents identified in accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

WHEREFORE, AT&T respectfully requests the Commission to grant its Motion for Temporary Protective Order in regard to its responses to OPC's First Set of Requests for Production of Documents to AT&T.


