## LCI'S NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST SPECIFIED CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION AND REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

requirements of a subpoena or court order, by Section 364.24, Florida Statutes. LCI has informed OPC that such documents will not be produced in the absence of such requirements.) The proprietary information includes, but is not limited to, trede secrets and information which, if disclosed, would harm LCI's business operations or its competitive posture and/or would harm ratepayers. LCI also moves for a Temporary Protective Order exempting these documents from Section 119.07, Florida Statutes.

3.
