I would greatly appreciate any assistance you can provide to these individuals.

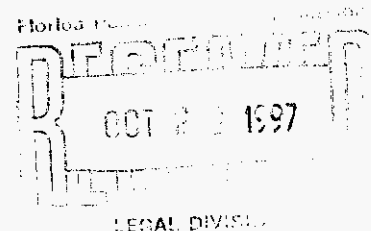

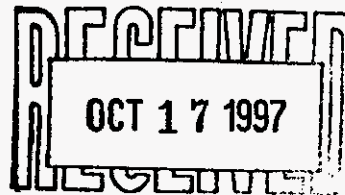
