AmeriSteel Corporation ("AmeriSteel") hereby requests the Florida Public Service Commission ("PSC" or "Commission") to refrain from rendering a final decision in the above-reference docket which could in any way jeopardize the ultimate outcome in a related and pending docket filed by AmeriSteel on December 11, 1997 entitled "Petitani of AmeriSteel for a Limited Proceeding to Reduce Florida Power & Light Company's Annual Revenues and for an Expedited Hearing Schedule" (the "New Docket").
