Issue 1: Should Pay Tele Communications, Inc. be ordered to show cause why it should not be fined \$3,250 pursuant to Section 364.285, Florida Statutes, or have its Certificate No. 3451 canceled for violation of Rule 25-24.515, Florida Administrative Code, Pay Telephone Service, Rule 25-24.520, Florida Administrative Code, Reporting Requirements, and Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code, Response to Commission Staff Inquiries.

Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should require Pay Tele to show cause in writing within 20 days of issuance of the Commission's order why it should not be fined \$750 for apparent violation of Rule 25-24.515, Florida Administrative Code, Pay Telephone Service, \$1,500 for violation of Rule 25-24.520, Florida Administrative Code, Reporting Requirements and \$1,000 for violation of Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code, Response to

Commission Staff Inquiries, or have its certificate canceled. If Pay Tele fails to respond to the show cause, the fines will be deemed assessed. If the fines are not paid within five business days of the expiration of the show cause response period, Pay Tele's certificate should be canceled. If the fines are paid, they should be forwarded to the office of the Comptroller for deposit in the Florida General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285, Florida Statutes.

**APPROVED**

Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. This docket should remain open pending resolution of the show cause proceeding. If, however, Pay Tele fails to respond to the Commission's order to show cause, the company's certificate should be canceled, and the docket should be closed administratively.
