REPORT OF MCI TELECOMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION

By Order No. PSC-98-0799-FOF-T1, the Florida Public Service Commission ordered MCI Telecommunications Corporation to provide prospective reductions to its inmate services surcharge on intrastate calls from the state inmate facilities it currently serves in Florida in an amount sufficient to equal \$189,482.49.

The \$189,483 represents unrefundable monies from over-collections of the intrastate collect surcharge for calls made between February 29, 1996 and July 10, 1996. Pursuant to the Commission's Order, MCI files its Report describing how the refund will be implemented.

\$	189,483	Total refund amount
	270,000	Average non-local intrastate calls per month
\$	0.70	Refund amount per call

MCI will reduce its intrastate, non-local inmate services surcharge by \$0.70 to \$1.05 for an interim period. While MCI will monitor the intrastate toll traffic from the inmate facilities, MCI believes it will be able to fully disburse the \$189,483 in approximately 30 days. MCI intends to implement the reduction beginning August 1, 1998.
