RE: BellSouth's Petitions for Waiver of Physical Collocation Requirements - Docket Nos. 980946-TL, 980947-TL, 980948-TL, 981011-TL, 981012-TL, 981250-TL

Pursuant to the discussions and input at our November 19th workshop on physical collocation, below is a list of issues that will be addressed in the dockets regarding BellSouth's petitions for waivers of physical collocation. We note that the dates for walk-throughs of BellSouth's central office have not been confirmed. At their earliest availability, those dates will be forwarded to you.

Issues

1. What factors, including alternative physical collocation arrangements, should be considered in determining if there is adequate space for physical collocation in the following BellSouth central offices:

- a) Daytona Beach Port Orange
b) Boca Raton Boca Teeca
c) Miami Palmetto
d) West Palm Beach Gardens
e) North Dade Golden Glades
f) Lake Mary

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2. What obligation does BellSouth have to make space available at these central offices to permit physical collocation pursuant to the Act and applicable state and federal requirements?

3. What factors should be considered in determining the reservation of space for planned and future use in a central office?

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4. If the Commission determines that a waiver request should be denied, how should BellSouth effectuate FCC Rule 47 C.F.R. §1.323(f)(1) in processing requests for physical collocation in that central office?
5. Should BellSouth's Petition of Waiver of the requirement to provide physical collocation in the following central offices be granted:
 - a) Daytona Beach Port Orange
 - b) Boca Raton Boca Teeca
 - c) Miami Palmetto
 - d) West Palm Beach Gardens
 - e) North Dade Golden Glades
 - f) Lake Mary

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
