Dear Telecommunications Carrier:

As you may be well aware, since May 1995 the telecommunications industry in Florida has been in a continuous process of implementing new area codes. During that time, the industry has implemented five new area codes in Florida, bringing the total number of area codes in Florida to eleven (11). In discussions with the numbering administrators about future exhausts of Florida area codes, it is apparent that this trend does not appear to be slowing down.

The Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC) continues to believe that the adoption of number pooling is in the public interest. Therefore, the FPSC is undertaking a major inventory of all area codes in Florida in an attempt to determine whether numbering resources are being used in an efficient manner. In addition, the Commission opened Docket No. 981444-TP to investigate and review all other number conservation aspects such as 1000-block pooling, 100-block pooling, non-sequential number pooling, and rate center consolidation to determine if these approaches could extend the life of area codes throughout Florida.

In an attempt to make the data collection process easier for your company, staff has provided specific instructions (Attachment I) to assist your company in responding to several questions listed in Attachment II. The Commission staff would appreciate it if your company could respond to all questions listed in Attachment II by Wednesday, April 7, 1999. You may either mail your response to Mr. Levent Ileri, or fax your response to (850) 413-6563.
