D. BASIC POSITION

The Florida Public Service Commission should not require code holders to distribute numbers consecutively, beginning with the lowest assignable telephone numbers. The Federal Communications Commission has specifically declined to delegate to the state commissions NXX code allocation or assignment. Numerous members of the industry, however, have entered into a Stipulation and Voluntary Number Management Measures, which we respectfully request the Commission to accept.

E. ISSUES AND POSITIONS

ISSUE 1: Should code holders be required to distribute telephone numbers consecutively, beginning with the lowest assignable telephone number?

If not, what alternative interim mechanism for number administration would be appropriate?

MCI WORLDCOM'S POSITION: No. Code holders should not be required to distribute telephone numbers consecutively, beginning with the lowest assignable telephone number. The Federal Communications Commission has specifically declined to delegate to the state commissions NXX code allocation or assignment. Numerous members of the industry, however, have entered into a Stipulation and Voluntary Number Management Measures, which we respectfully request the Commission to accept.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

MCI WORLDCOM'S POSITION: Yes.

F. PENDING MOTIONS

The Joint Motion to Accept Stipulation and Voluntary Number Conservation Measures is pending at this time.

G. REQUIREMENTS THAT CANNOT BE COMPLIED WITH

All requirements of the procedural orders can be met by MCI WorldCom.
