
Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and Columbia Telecommunications, Inc. are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission an amendment to their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks, the unbundling of specific network elements offered by BellSouth and the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services to Columbia Telecommunications, Inc. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. PSC-98-1450-FOF-TP issued October 26, 1998 in Docket 981004-TP.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and Columbia Telecommunications, Inc. within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.

Second Amendment to Interconnection Agreement
by and between
BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.
and
Columbia Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a axessa
dated July 22, 1999, as First Amended in March, 1999

Columbia Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a aXessa and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") hereby agree that BellSouth shall provide the following network elements at the following negotiated Regional Rates:


Element	Rate
DS1 – Loop (Each DS1-Loop includes 24 lines)	
Recurring Per Month	\$ 70.45
Nonrecurring Price for 1 st DS1 Loop	\$641.55
Add'l Nonrecurring Price of Add'l DS1 Loop	\$416.89
Interoffice Transport – Dedicated DS1 Transport (each DS1 contains 24 lines)	
Dedicated DS1 – Facilities Termination, per month	\$ 85.75
Nonrecurring Price for First DS1 Transport	\$151.50
Additional Nonrecurring Price for all Add'l DS1 Transport	\$118.87
Dedicated DS1 – per Mile, per month	\$ 0.57

1. Unbundled 4-Wire DS1 Loop and the Unbundled DS1 Interoffice Transport Regional Rates are only available if the loop and transport are ordered together on the same Local Service Request at the same time, which elements must be used together and disconnected at the same time.
2. The total combined nonrecurring charge for a 4-Wire DS1 Loop and the Unbundled DS1 Interoffice Transport will be \$793.05 1st 4-Wire DS1 Loop and Transport and \$535.76 for Add'l loop and transport network elements.
3. DS1 Loop and Interoffice Transport shall have such meaning as set forth in Attachment 1 of this Agreement.

4. The Target Intervals that shall apply to the provision of the unbundled 4-wire DS1 Loop and the unbundled DS1 Interoffice Transport shall be as set forth on the BellSouth web page, as amended from time to time, at the internet address noted on the copy of the current Target Intervals attached hereto.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have executed this Agreement effective this 6 day of June, 1999.


