Recommendation: Yes. The Commission should accept the settlement offer proposed by Cendant.



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Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. With the approval of Issue 1, this docket should remain open pending remittance of the \$25,000 voluntary contribution and overcharges refund of \$13,064.98. Cendant will remit the settlement proposed within 10 business days from the issuance date of the Commission Order. Upon remittance of the settlement payment, this docket should be closed. The settlement total \$38,064.98 should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the company fails to pay in accordance with the terms of its settlement offer, the company's certificate should be canceled administratively with an effective date 5 days after the settlement payment was due.
