You were correct that the utility did submit its original certificate with Mr. Kennedy's January 20, 1999 response to notice of deficiencies. I apologize that we weren't able to locate it before. Based on your representation that you will be withdrawing the above-referenced application for amendment, we are returning the utility's original certificate with this letter. Staff was also able to locate the original tariff sheets inadvertently sent with your January 20, 1999 letter. Whenever an application requires the filing of tariff sheets, the sheets will either be new revised sheets (as is the case of a territory amendment) or new originals (as in the case of a name change or transfer of certificate). The original tariff sheets should always remain at the utility office once approved.

I'm sorry this application for amendment has been troublesome for you. Unfortunately, the requirement to notice, the affidavits of the notice, and the need for service are across-the-board requirements specifically set forth in, or suggested by, Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, upon which the Commission's amendment rule is based. Neither staff nor the Commissioners have the authority to waive any statutory requirement.

I understand that you may be submitting a narrower application for extension to an area that $\frac{1}{2}$ may need service soon. Applications based on an actual request for service should not be $\frac{\alpha}{100}$ controversial. Please feel free to contact either myself or a member of my staff, Ms. Billie Messer, 🛱 $\overline{\mathbf{pr}}$ for to filing so we can ensure you receive another copy of the filing requirements and an up-to-date $\overline{\mathbf{z}}$ DOCUMENT list for noticing.
