THE COALITION'S MOTION TO RECONSIDER ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

Petitioner, the COALITION FOR EQUITABLE RATES ("Coalition") petitions for reconsideration of Order No. PSC-99-1633-PCO-EI (the "Order") issued in Docket No. 990250-EI, pursuant to Rules 25-22.0376 and 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. In support of this Motion, the Coalition states:

1. Previously, a preliminary Time Schedule (CASR) for Docket 990250-EI indicated that a Final Hearing would be scheduled for January 25, 2000. Intervenor testimony would have been due on October 25, 1999 under this schedule. A copy of that Time Schedule is attached as Exhibit A.

2. On August 23, 1999, Commissioner and Prehearing Officer J. Terry

Deason issued an Order Establishing Procedure in this docket which, for unexplained

reasons, advanced the Final Hearing by three months, scheduling it for November 1,

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- 1999. That Order also compressed the time allotted between key activities. Intervenor testimony is now due on September 20, 1999. A copy of that Order is attached as Exhibit B.
- 3. The Coalition will call Charlie King of Washington D.C. as its primary expert in this matter. Mr. King has been on vacation since the August 23, 1999 issuance of the Prehearing Order and is not scheduled to return until September 7, 1999.
- 4. The Coalition requests that the Commission extend the deadline for Intervenor's testimony in this case for a period of two weeks in order to allow adequate time for preparation of its expert and testimony. Thus, the Coalition seeks that its direct testimony and exhibits be presented on October 4, 1999.
- 5. The Coalition would correspondingly request that the schedule of other key activities be likewise extended in order to avoid prejudice to any party, while maintaining the same date for Hearing and the filing of Briefs as established in the Order Establishing Procedure. Thus, the following revised schedule is sought:

6. Gulf Power does not object to this Motion. Alternatively, both the Coalition and Gulf Power would not object to a schedule which continues the Hearing for a period of approximately two weeks, or until the week of November 15, 1999, with a Prehearing Conference on November 1, 1999 and Briefs due November 29, 1999. Staff for the Public Service Commission opposes this Motion.

WHEREFORE, the Coalition respectfully requests the PSC to enter an order modifying the Order Establishing Procedure as suggested above. Oral argument is respectfully requested.
