ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

By Petition, Network Telephone Corporation (Network Telephone) has requested permission to intervene in this proceeding. Network Telephone states that it is a competitive Local Exchange Company (ALEC) certified to operate in Florida. As an integrated communications provider, Network Telephone contends that it will be purchasing unbundled network elements from BellSouth in Florida, particularly unbundled copper loops. Network Telephone states that the Commission will be addressing the rates for unbundled copper loops in this proceeding, and as such, any decision made could affect the substantial interests of Network Telephone.

Having reviewed the Petition, it appears that Network Telephone's substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding because it is a certified ALEC that may purchase unbundled network elements from BellSouth in Florida. Therefore, the Petition shall be granted. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, Network Telephone takes the case as it finds it.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by Network Telephone Corporation is hereby granted. It is further

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.569(1), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in

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the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
