<u>Issue 2</u>: What is the appropriate security to guarantee the increased revenues collected under the proposed final rates?

<u>Recommendation</u>: The escrow agreement filed by the utility on December 8, 2000, should be accepted to guarantee any potential refund of revenues collected under the proposed final rates. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.360(6), Florida Administrative Code, the utility should be required to provide a report by the 20th of each month indicating the monthly and total revenues collected subject to refund. Further, in no instance should the administrative costs of any refunds be borne by the customers. The costs are the responsibility of, and should be borne by, the utility.
