ACG Telecom Services, Inc., is filing this petition for a formal proceeding to review the orders outlined in Docket No. 001337-TI. The orders affecting ACG Telecom Services, Inc., were issued by the Florida Public Service Commission on January 9, 2001. We received a copy of the order by mail at our corporate address shown above. This was received approximately one week after the order was issued.

In the January 9, 2001, orders ACG Telecom Services, Inc., was fined \$500 for failure to pay the 1999 Regulatory Assessment Fee and was to have its Interexchange Telecommunications Certificate cancelled. ACG Telecom Services, Inc., does not dispute the facts outlined in the order.

ACG Telecom Services, Inc., has filed and paid its 1999 Regulatory Assessment Fee which totaled \$69.00—including interest and penalties—to prevent cancellation of our certificate. ACG Telecom Services, Inc., had hired an accounting firm to complete all state regulatory filings. We, however, failed in our responsibility to properly oversee the activities of our representatives. As such, we have relieved our accounting firm of their duties to perform regulatory filings and have chosen to perform this task using our own staff. As president of ACG Telecom Services, Inc., I have chosen to personally monitor and reviewed each filing to ensure its accuracy and timeliness.

In view of the fact that ACG Telecom Services, Inc., did not operate in Florida during 1999, I would request that the Florida Public Service Commission reduce the fine imposed from \$500 to \$100. This \$100 penalty represents 200% of the amount owed by ACG Telecom Services, Inc., for its 1999 Regulatory Assessment Fee. ACG Telecom Services, Inc., began providing services in Florida approximately seven months ago, and we intend to substantially increase our presence in Florida throughout 2001. We intend to provide only the highest quality of service to the citizens of the state of Florida and will take all necessary steps to preserve the privilege that the Public Service Commission has given us to operate within the state.
