As identified in the Order Amending Certificates in this docket, Order No. PSC-00-2243-PAA-WS, the utility is currently providing water and wastewater service to Palm Valley Manufactured Housing Community as a general service customer. With regard to reuse service, Staff is aware that reuse lines have not been installed, and that certain basic details regarding reuse service provision have been unresolved. Previously, Staff was informed that the utility would be providing the reuse service to certain individual lots. Please be advised that it has been determined that consistent with the manner water and wastewater service is currently being provided, reuse service will be provided directly to Palm Valley Manufactured Housing Community as a general service customer. The general service customer will then be responsible for running the reuse lines and determining which residents of the community will receive the reuse water, depending on engineering and any other applicable considerations. For this reason, the re-use tariff submitted is for general service instead of residential.
