Re: Docket No. 990256-WU, Application for transfer of facilities from Gem Estates Utilities, Inc., in Pasco County to Gem Estates Mobile Home Village Association, Inc., and cancellation of Certificate No. 563-W.

Dear Mr. Ott:

Congratulations on Gem Estates Mobile Home Village Association, Inc.'s (GEMHVA) recent purchase of the community's common area and water utility facilities. Staff has received, and filed, the copy you provided of the contract documents. In addition, staff has received a preliminary statement from GEMHVA's attorney with respect to GEMHVA's exempt status. It is staff's understanding that the attorney is gathering additional confirmation from the residents in Gem Estates. Therefore, the only remaining filing requirement, appears to be the notice the transfer.

Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code, requires that three notices of transfer be given: (1) to local utilities and governments, (2) to customers of the utility, and (3) in newspaper of general circulation. Also, a notarized statement (affidavit) of when each notice is given must be provided to the Commission. To aid GEMHVA with the noticing requirements, staff is attaching a copy of the notice in the required format. The only information left for GEMHVA to complete is the date the notices are actually given.

(1) Notice to local utilities and governments. Staff is providing a copy of the list of local utilities and governments which need to be noticed under this provision of the rule. All GEMHVA needs to do is send one copy of the notice (with the "date given" filled-in) by regular mail to each entity on the list. Then, after the notices are mailed, GEMHVA needs to provide an affidavit to the Commission of the date the notice was mailed. Attached to the affidavit should be a copy of the actual notice along with a copy of **MECUMENT NO** attached list.

(2) <u>Notice to customers of the utility</u>. Staff believes that requiring notice to customers of the utility, when the transfer is to those same customers, would be counterproductive. Under these circumstances, staff is not going to require that notice to customers be given.

(3) <u>Publication of notice</u>. GEMHVA needs to publish the attached notice, at least once, in a newspaper of general circulation in the area of the utility. The date this notice is given is the date it is published in the newspaper. The affidavit of the publishing should be provided by the newspaper.

Obviously, the noticing should be done as soon as possible so that the application can be processed. In any event, please try to have the noticing complete by <u>March 23</u>, <u>2001</u>.
