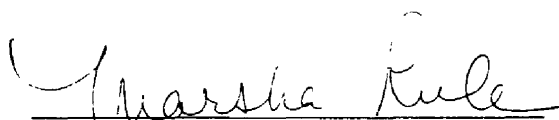

Line Splitter Rate Filings in BellSouth Region

In this arbitration, AT&T has requested BellSouth to provide the splitter for line splitting purposes (that is, when AT&T provides the voice service under UNE-P and another provider provides the data service over the same line). AT&T has not proposed rates for a splitter in this docket or elsewhere in the BellSouth region because AT&T has been relying on cost litigation done by data CLECs, but the rate should be the same whether the splitter is used for line splitting or line sharing. This Commission removed an issue regarding splitter cost from the UNE Cost Docket (No. 990649-TP) and therefore has not yet set a rate for the splitter.
