This letter is in response to the PSC Staff's request for additional information in the above-referenced docket:

- 1.a) HUC did not amend its certificate at that time it began serving the few properties in question because they believed they were within their certificated territory. Further, at that time, there were no other wastewater providers in the area to bring to HUC's attention that the properties were not within its certificated service area. It was only when HUC began preparing maps in connection with settling its lawsuit against the City of Sebring that it realized it was serving outside of its service area.
- b) Copies of the Agreements are attached hereto.
- c) The description of the facilities which HUC received as a result of the Agreements referenced above are described in such Agreements.
- 2. On February 9, 2001, we filed an amended Exhibit "C" which is the revised legal description in accordance with Commission Rules.

RE: Job Description-New School Located County Road 29, Lake Placid

Highlands Utilities Corp. is capable of furnishing sewer facilities for the new school. The capacity fee which is the amount of flow reserved in our sewer plant as per engineers design is 13,000 gallons per day. The cost to you to allow this flow to enter our plant is based on \$2.00 per gallon. This amount is \$26,000.00. This is a one time charge which pays only for the space which is reserved in our plant for the 13,000 gallons. If this flow is increased above the original 13,000 gallons at any time there will be an additional \$2.00 per gallon charge for the additional flow. The capacity fee payment is required whenever the permits are pulled on the building. At this time an application is required from HUCO to be filled out by the responsible party.

The monthly rate at the present time is figured as follows:

\$11.00 for the first 4,000 gallons \$2.00 per additional 1,000 gallons of sewage treated

The flow rate is figured on the meter readings per month. I suggest that the water that is used for irrigation not be tied in with the in house water so that the readings will only reflect flow from the building.

Our company is at the present time awaiting a rate increase from P.S.C. (Florida Public Service Commission) in Tallahassee. This new rate should become in effect after September 1987. The preliminary rates from P.S.C. is figured on a base facility charge according to the size of meter. The meter sizes are listed below since we do not know what size meter your building will require.

For example if the school uses a 3" meter the base facility charge would be \$231.36 plus the \$1.93 per additional 1,000 gallons treated. If you use 100,000 gallons per month the cost of treating this amount of flow would be \$424.36.

Highlands Utilities Corp. will do the force main to the school site at our cost. Our company will not be responsible for any on site construction.

There will be a lift station required to pump this flow to our sewer plant. Pugh Septic Tank Service, Inc. does all of the biddings on the lift stations for Highlands Utilities. If Highlands Utilities maintains the lift station and pays the electric the lift station must be put in according to HUCO specifications. Pugh Septic Tank Service bid for the lift station is \$9,000.00, which is according to HUCO's specifications.

If the boards engineers has its own design and would like to maintain the system as well as pay the electric, Pugh also would bid on this lift station if the board would desire.
