AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. ("AT&T"), hereby claims pursuant to Section 364.183(1), Florida Statutes, that certain information contained in Commission's Staff Audit, Audit Control No. 00-067-3-1, in the above referenced docket, contains proprietary confidential business information that should be held exempt from public disclosure. Consistent with Rule 25-22.006(5), Florida Administrative Code, since the Commission already has a copy of the Audit Report and workpapers, and the workpapers are voluminous, an additional copy is not being provided since the entire contents of the workpapers are being claimed confidential. Attached hereto as Exhibit A is an itemized list that details the workpapers which are claimed to be confidential. The audit report, identified as "Audit Exception No. 1," is not being claimed confidential.

The Audit report and workpapers were transmitted to Ms. Rhonda Merritt, Assistant Vice President of AT&T, by letter dated February 7, 2001. Because of a family emergency, Ms. Merritt - was unable to personally receive the Audit Report and workpapers although another company employee accepted them on her behalf. Because of Ms. Merritt's absence from the office due to the family emergency, and a miscommunication regarding the receipt of the Audit Report by undersigned counsel, this request is being filed today as opposed to within the 21 days specified by Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(2), Florida Administrative Code. AT&T believes these circumstances combined with the fact that the information which is claimed confidential consists of customer - telephone records, which are always exempt from public disclosure pursuant to section 119.07(3)(r), Florida Statutes, and trade secrets, internal audit controls, security measures, and sensitive ATE
