In response to your telephone conversation with Johnny Butts on March 12, 2001, I would like to take this opportunity to once again inform you exactly what actions are required in the above referenced docket. On March 6, 2001, the Commission approved staff's recommendation on your request for a payment plan for past due RAFs for the periods of 1998 and 1999. By this action, you are required to submit five monthly payments of \$1,320.65 to this Commission by the 20th of each month. The first payment is due to the Commission on Tuesday, March 20, 2001.

In addition, the Commission also made the decision that you must pay the RAFs associated with revenues for the end of calendar year December 31, 2000. The 2000 RAF payment is to be paid in full by March 31, 2001. If any of the payments are **not** received on the due dates, the current docket will will close and we will initiate a show cause and revocation of certificate docket.

I am extremely concerned that you indicated that you did not understand what actions were required of you, especially since we met with you immediately after the Commission's vote and fully explained what actions are required. I cannot express the importance of this requirement. If any of these payments are not received by this Commission in a timely fashion, subequent revocation proceedings could result in your operating certificate for your water company being revoked.
