Although AT&T and BellSouth were successful in settling or otherwise disposing of a number of issues in this docket, the remaining issues are complex and the supporting testimony voluminous. Attorneys for AT&T have diligently attempted to review for the Commission in a meaningful fashion the record in this docket, consisting of thousands of pages of testimony and exhibits in addition to a hearing transcript of nearly 1500 pages. In the interests of fully briefing the issues in this docket, AT&T requests leave to file a post-hearing brief of 58 pages, which is eight pages in excess of the page limit set in Order No. PSC-01-0324-PHO-TP, issued in this docket on February 6, 2001.

BellSouth counsel has advised that BellSouth will not oppose this motion.


WHEREFORE, AT&T respectfully requests that the Commission grant its motion to file a post-hearing brief in excess of 50 pages.
